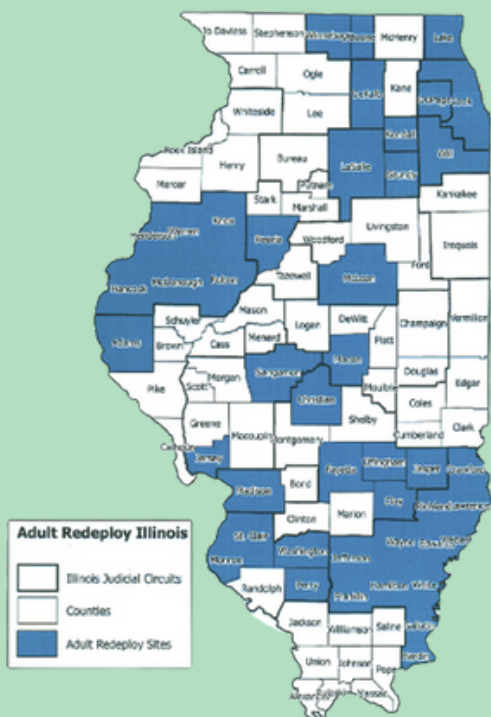




SFY20 IMPACT REPORT

MEASURING IMPACT, SEEKING SOLUTIONS

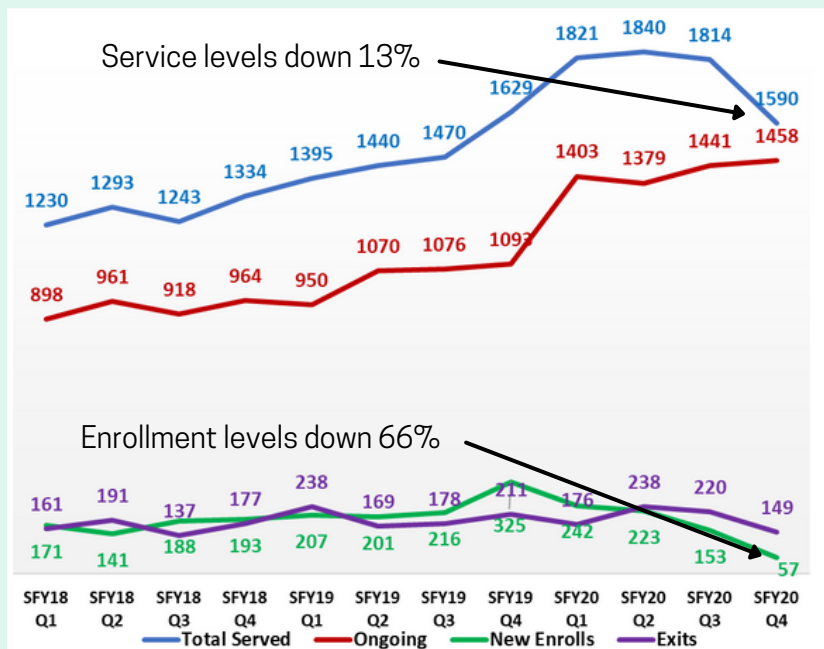


Southern Illinois University-Carbondale conducted ARI's first **external evaluation**.



We worked with Corporation for Supportive Housing to study **housing needs** of justice-involved individuals.

OPERATING IN THE TIME OF COVID



ARI sites and their clients suffered serious disruptions due to COVID:

- Courtrooms closed.
- ARI enrollment levels dropped 66%.
- Service levels dropped 13%.
- Supervision and services went virtual.
- Program staff struggled to maintain client engagement and prevent relapse and recidivism.

A CRITICAL MISSION

The **mission** of Adult Redeploy Illinois (ARI) is to safely reduce prison use by building local systems that divert individuals from a prison sentence into more cost-effective programs that promote their reintegration into the community.

Never has this mission been more critical. We will continue to work toward our **vision** of an equitable justice system that protects public safety and increases access to interventions, allowing people to avoid prison and lead productive lives in their community.
