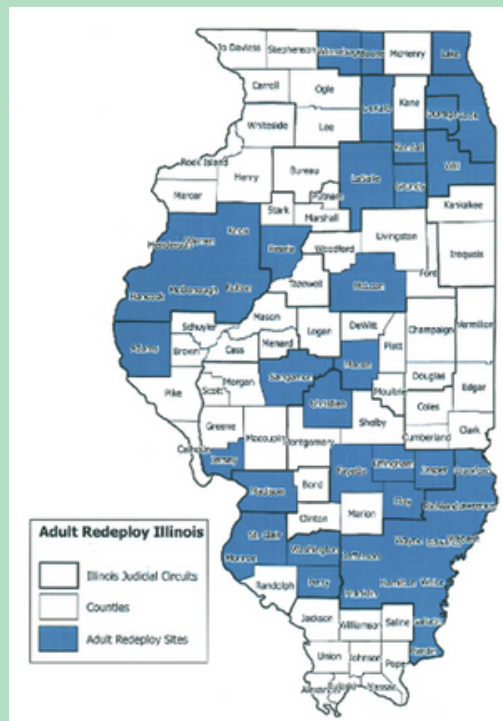




# ADULT REDEPLOY ILLINOIS

## SFY21 IMPACT REPORT

In SFY21, **Adult Redeploy Illinois** supported its sites as they worked during a pandemic to provide safe alternatives to incarceration for people with behavioral health disorders. 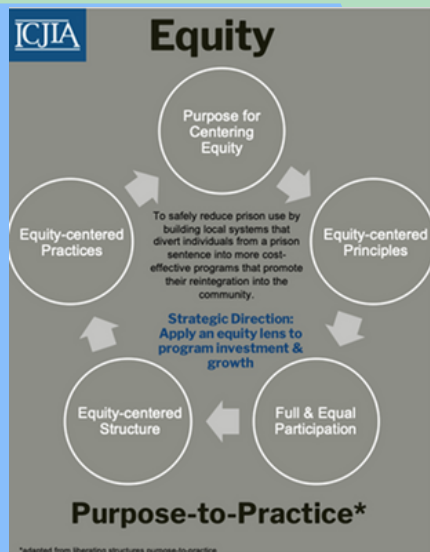
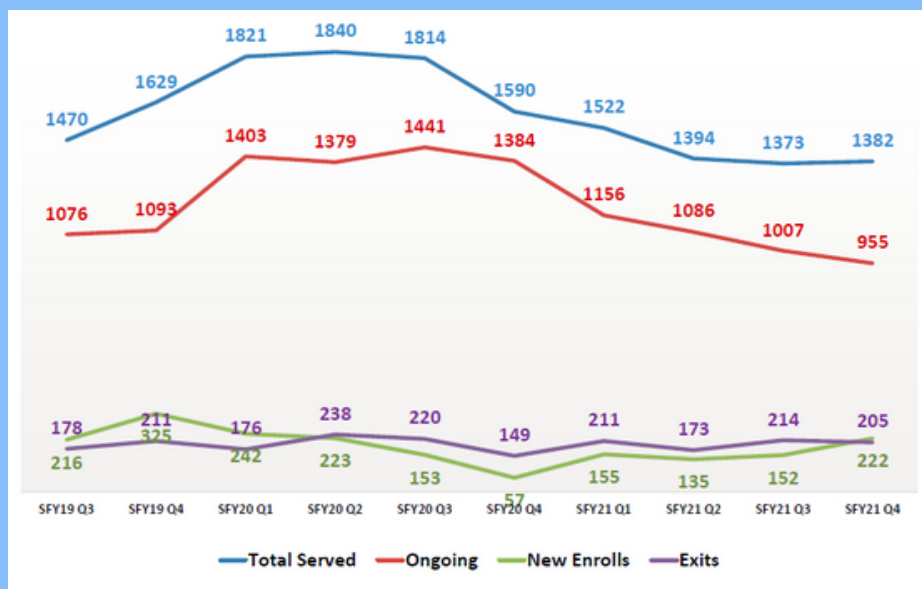

Service levels began to rebound in SFY21 from the worst effects of the pandemic on court operations. Sites enrolled clients and provided individualized supervision and support.

Vital Voices aims to center the voices of ARI participants in efforts to increase justice, equity and opportunity.

An exciting new initiative was launched in SFY21 to increase the role of ARI participants and alumni in program development and decision-making. The **Vital Voices** project provided opportunities for clients to share their experiences with ARI, ICJIA, and the public, and to influence the Oversight Board.

ARI held the Vital Voices community forum in March 2021 and conducted a series of small group discussions. Sites submitted quarterly impact stories in clients' own words.
