In SFY25 Q4, ARI sites reported providing **more than 2,000 individuals** with community-based supervision and services in lieu of incarceration. The increase was due to adding two new sites: Cook County Mental Health Courts and Peoria County Problem-Solving Court.

In SFY25 in partnership with **Training, Technical Assistance, and Development (TTAD)** program providers, the ARI network explored ways to incorporate strengths-based coaching in their work while implementing data-driven and evidence-informed strategies to promote public safety, ensure accountability, and support rehabilitation.

This was the focus of the **2025 All-Sites Summit** which was attended by more than 100 site representatives. The robust learning agenda included a coaching session led by people with lived experience in ARI-funded diversion programs, a.k.a. Vital Voices.
